

Environmental Concerns in Tel Aviv-Jaffa 2003-2008

1. The Northern Coast – Promise of a coastal park alongside development
2. Gililot – Solution to an environmental disaster, and the promise of a natural park
3. Cessation of air pollution from the Reading power plant
4. Yarkon Park – Cancellation of construction of high power lines and avoiding additional construction
5. Tel Aviv Port – Preserving "Yarid Hamizrach" and holding a public discussion on the topic
6. "Kohav Hazafon" – Relocating a proposed new arena to the city entrance
7. Congress Center – Agreement to expand the site only upon completion of the light railway
8. Dan garage – Allocation of space for public use and adjusting height of construction
9. Area around northern train station – Guaranteeing open green spaces and environmental planning
10. "No" to the Weitzman Bridge – Opposition to yet another passenger car bridge over the Yarkon River
11. Ramat Hachayal – Construction of this industrial area only with provision of the light railway
12. Neve Sharett Wadi – Promise of a park in the area alongside any future construction
13. "No" to the Ayalon Highway East – Provide budget for public transportation
14. Hamedina Square – Guaranteeing public spaces and environmental planning
15. Rabin Square – Holding a public discussion on the square's future: no to underground parking
16. The Light Railway – Commitment to construction of a light rail line on Ibn Gvirol street within five years
17. Habima Square – Underground parking would create a severe environmental hazard
18. Sheinkin Street – Plan to make the street a pedestrian mall again
19. Kiryat Sefer – Implementing the commitment to an inner city park
20. Nahlat Binyamin – The pedestrian mall is disappearing!
21. Southern edge of the Defense Ministry – Protect old Sharona and divert commuters to public transportation
22. Begin-Petach Tikva Road – Plan the roadway as a city boulevard and not as another Ayalon Highway
23. Nahlat Yitzchak neighborhood – Guaranteeing quality of life even alongside a commercial area
24. Beachfront – Stop directing sewage into the open sea!
25. Montefiore neighborhood – Protect the neighborhood's heritage values
26. East Tel Aviv – Deal with pollution of the land.
27. Bitzron – Guaranteeing quality of life even alongside a commercial area
28. Herbert Samuel Promenade – A pedestrian promenade along the eastern side as well
29. Neve Zedek – Reject the road through this neighborhood
30. Wholesale market – Guarantee green spaces
31. Shapira neighborhood – Overall renewal rather than localized 'destroy and rebuild' process
32. Abu Kabir groves – Site for a potential park in the southwestern part of the city
33. Neve Ofer – The tunnelization of the southern part of the Ayalon Highway
34. Jaffa Port – Implement the commitment for an active public space
35. Jerusalem Boulevard – Guaranteeing the contribution of the light railway to the boulevard's renewal
36. Ajami Neighborhood – Deal with the environmental neglect of the neighborhood
37. The Jaffa slope – Remove the pile of refuse and reconnect the neighborhood to the sea
38. Establish a public system to oversee the cutting/and pruning of trees in the city
39. Get the Municipality to commit to a multiyear plan that would significantly reduce air pollution
40. Get the Municipality to commit to reducing the level of noise in the city
41. Stop the regular increase of public parking spaces for offices
42. Improving public transportation in the city and completing the plan for bicycle trails
43. Commitment to increasing public involvement in city issues
